Telephone Consultation Clinic

West Lothian Child and Adolescent Mental health Services (CAMHS), offer a telephone consultation service for professionals who work with children and young people from age 0-18 years.

The telephone consultation service is to give professionals the opportunity to discuss their experiences of the child or young person from an emotional, behavioural or mental health perspective. Advice and recommendations will be agreed, and may include, discussion of current supports and interventions, signposting to relevant resources and services, an invite to book and attend a direct consultation clinic with other professionals involved in that child/young person's care or may be a referral to CAMHS.

CAMHS Clinicians will cover telephone consultation on a daily basis (excluding weekends and public holidays).
